Use these supplementary pages to tell HMRC about your capital gains and losses when filing your trust and estate tax return.

[CG34 Post Transaction Valuation Checks for capital gains](#)

Use this form to ask HMRC to check the valuation you have used when working out your Capital Gains Tax.

[50\(FS\) Trust Gains and Capital Payments](#)

If you're a settlor or beneficiary of a trust, use this form to tell HMRC about any payments, income or gains from a settlement. HMRC will then work out if you need to pay any Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax.

[SA100 Tax Return](#)

If you're an individual, use this form to file your Self Assessment tax return, tell HMRC about your income and capital gains and claim tax reliefs.

[SA900 Trust and Estate Tax Return](#)

If you're handling a trust or estate, use this form to file your Self Assessment tax return.
